Mystery and Crime Writer Agatha Christie was born in Torquay in 1890 and spent many years in the area that was a source of inspiration for many of her works.

Torquay - Her birthplace, home of the Agatha Christie Mile

Brixham - Part of the English Riviera synonymous with Christie's work

Paignton & Dartmouth steam railway - Agatha loved train travel and this railway has featured both in her books and TV adaptations

Itinerary
