HOTEL DE LA PLACE, LISIEUX

- Thursday 4th June We depart from local pick up points as follows and travel to Dover for the ferry to Calais at 12h15, with comfort stops enroute. On arrival at Calais we will make our way to the town of Lisieux, situated in central Normandy. Arrive at hotel early evening for check-in.
- Friday 5th June Breakfast will be in two sittings at 7.30am and 8.15am (you will be told which sitting you should go to). The coach will depart from outside the hotel at 9.15am
Parade at Coleville-Montgomery at 11.30am
Wreath laying at Ouistreham and stop at Douvres Cemetery
Return to hotel mid afternoon for free evening
- Saturday 6th June Breakfast will be in two sittings at 7.30am and 8.15am (you will be told which sitting you should go to). The coach will depart from outside the hotel at 9.15am
Parade at Bayeux at 11.30am
Afternoon in Arromanches with medals ceremony at 16h00 and parade at 18h00
Return to hotel early evening for free evening
- Sunday 7th June Breakfast will be in two sittings at 7.30am and 8.15am (you will be told which sitting you should go to). The coach will depart from outside the hotel at 9.15am
Visit to the Pegasus Bridge and Centre Juno Beach
Return to the hotel late afternoon for free evening
- Monday 8th June Breakfast will be in two sittings at 7.30am and 8.15am (you will be told which sitting you should go to). The coach will depart from outside the hotel at 9.15am
Visit to Omaha Beach and the American Cemetery
Return to the hotel late afternoon for free evening
- Tuesday 9th June Breakfast will be in two sittings at 7.30am and 8.15am (you will be told which sitting you should go to). The coach will depart from outside the hotel at 9.30am for our return journey to Calais & ferry crossing to Dover at 15h25, with comfort stops enroute. From Dover we will continue our homeward journey to Leicestershire, arriving back at the first pick up point early evening.
